ACC recently implemented NetSuite as their integrated ERP system. With the system bedding into all departments and international offices they needed support in the final delivery of NetSuite, building reporting and analytics functionality to support and drive the day to day business.

I was Initially tasked with assisting the finance team. This involved extensive requirements gathering with each team member to enable me to understand their specific financial reporting needs to be able to perform their day to day duties and also enable them to build their management accounts pack specifically from data pulled from NetSuite.

Some of the main Financial Reports Created included:

P&L to include impact of unapproved transactions

Balance Sheet

A/P and A/R Aging

Saved searches to create journals for Accrued Costs & Revenue and Deferred Costs & Revenue

Monthly GP Report broken down by broker Contributions for all regions

Overdue Invoices

Supplier Payment holds

Monthly Report of total invoice values per customer

Once the reports were signed off by the CFO, I tailored and published dashboards for each member of the finance team.

This process was then repeated for the other departments within the business: ACMI, Charter, Interiors. Reporting on specific KPI's for each area and publishing Dashboards to support each Director and the individual Brokers.

In total I created and published unique Dashboards for 16 roles shared between 48 Users.

NetSuite OneWorld implementation for Tomorrow London Ltd

Tomorrow London began their NetSuite OneWorld Implementation in October 2018. I joined the project in March, just as the Finance Team were about to go live and I was able to undertake the essential NetSuite Administrator go live support tasks, including:

- Subsidiary management
- Customer/Vendor setup
- Data management
- System configuration and customization of forms, fields and records
- Provision and development of financial reports and saved searches
- Troubleshooting errors and issues within NetSuite

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- Creation of users, managing user access and maintaining system access/roles and permissions
 - Providing end user training and supporting documentation
 - Providing ongoing support

Phase 2 of the project covered Design to Build, Order to Cash, Procure to Pay and Ecommerce. I was involved in each of those work streams, taking the lead on the Procure to Pay process which included:

- Having responsibility for the integration with Tomorrow London's 3PL integration partner Patchworks and ensuring all Procure to Pay processes were successfully implemented with Tomorrow London's Integrated Warehouses.
- Liaising daily with Patchworks throughout the integration and undertaking extensive testing in a number of areas including:
 - Purchase Orders
 - Inventory Adjustments
 - Transfer Orders
 - Vendor Returns
 - Customer Returns
- Go Live preparation with individual users including creation of user adoption documentation, assisting with User Acceptance Testing and leading multiple workshops and demonstrations of NetSuite functionality.
- Creation and publication of several, highly complex Saved Searches, to satisfy the business' reporting needs.
- Creation and publication of dashboards for multiple users of the Operations & Logistics teams, achieved through requirements gathering to understand the key measures that needed to be included.
- Undertaking a significant amount of Data Migration. Migrating open Purchase Orders from SAP into NetSuite via CSV import. The original Excel files exported from SAP required extensive manipulation in order to get them into an acceptable format for NetSuite.
